2024 Scholarship Application

Country Dancers of Rochester, Inc. (CDR) is an educational organization which is dedicated to the preservation, study, teaching, enjoyment and continuing evolution of English and American traditional and historical dance and dance music. CDR believes that those goals are furthered by providing financial support for members to gain experience and expertise that would directly benefit our dance community.

Every year we distribute scholarship support totaling \$500 to one or more members to help cover the expenses of attendance at a dance-related event or activity. Preference will be given to applicants with the most potential to provide long term benefits to the CDR community by increasing their skills, knowledge and experience.

- Applicants must be active members of CDR. If you're not yet a member, you can join at any dance by filling out a membership application. or on our website at https://cdrochester.org/about-cdr/membership/
- Proposed dance activities must be related to English and American traditional and historical dance and/or
 music. A preference will be given to applications that are directly related to Contra or English Country
 Dancing.
- Applicants must describe on the application the benefit that their proposed activity will bring to the Country Dancers of Rochester dance community.
- CDR reserves the right to award scholarship money either in full to one applicant or in partial amounts to multiple applicants.
- As a CDSS affiliate organization, CDR's members receive priority consideration for admission to CDSS camps when there is high demand.
- After the scholarship supported dance event, all recipients are required to share their experience with the CDR community through a blog article, delivered within 60 days of the completion of the activity.
- Additionally, all scholarship recipients must serve on the CDR scholarship committee for two years.
- If you're interested in a CDSS Dance week, we encourage you to also apply for CDSS scholarship support. CDSS will match CDR's contribution, and both CDSS and Pinewoods Dance Camp have other scholarships.
